Subscription for 2007

Subscriptions for 2007 are now due. Rates are unchanged. *Honorary Members* are exempt from paying subscriptions. *Life Members* are exempt from paying annual subscriptions. *Founder Members*, *Ordinary Members*, *Student Members* and *Associates* from the following European countries qualify for the lower tier of annual subscriptions: Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Bosnia & Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Estonia, Former Yugoslav Republic Of Macedonia, Georgia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Poland, Rumania, the Russian Federation, Serbia & Montenegro, Slovakia, Turkey, Ukraine. All others pay the upper tier of annual subscriptions. For *Sustaining Members* there is only one tier. Societies may join corporately only as *Ordinary* or *Sustaining Members*. Annual subscriptions for 2007 are therefore as follows:

- €20 / €10 (upper / lower tier) for *Founder Members* and *Ordinary Members*;
- €10 / €5 (upper / lower tier) for *Student Members* and *Associates*;
- €500 for *Sustaining Members*.

The subscription for *Life Membership* is a single payment equivalent to 15 × the *Founder Member / Ordinary Member* annual subscription: €300 / €150 (upper / lower tier).

Methods for paying subscriptions

Members and *Associates* should send their subscription for 2007 to Dr S. Diamandis, EMA **Treasurer** (address: NAGREF - Forest Research Institute, Vassiliki, Thessaloniki, 57006, Greece. Fax: +30 2310 461341. E-mail: diamandi@fri.gr). Whichever way you pay, please ensure you cover the Bank fee, because the correct subscription must reach the EMA. Optional further donations above the subscription rate are gratefully received and will be added to the EMA's benefactors' fund for promoting mycology in Europe.

When making payments, please note that, for **Bank transfer**, **Cheque** and **Eurocheque** in Euro the bank fee is 0.50 for amounts less than €1,000. For cheques in other currencies the bank fee is €3 + 1%. In all cases, please also alert the Treasurer by e-mail, so that he knows about the payment and the manner in which it is being made. He will then be able to update his records.

Payments can be made by:

- **Bank transfer** (bank remittance), payable to the European Mycological Association in Euro at Piraeus Bank, Themi, bank code 2216. The EMA Account "IBAN" number is: GR48 0172 2160 0052 1602 2650 182. The SWIFT-BIC of the Bank is: PIRBGRAA.
- **Cheque**, payable to the European Mycological Association in Euro.
- **Eurocheque**, payable to the European Mycological Association in Euro.
- **Postal transfer** (through Western Union), payable in Euro to **Dr Stephanos Diamandis** (NOT to the *European Mycological Association*). In Postal transfers the commission is nearly €10. Use it only if there are at least 4 members willing to pay their subscription together (e.g. members working in the same institute).
